The St. Louis Office for DD Resources (DD Resources) is a public taxing entity, commonly known as a “Senate Bill 40 Board.” The organization was established in 1988 when St. Louis City voters approved a tax to develop services and support for residents with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). The in-house Targeted Case Management department serves over 505 individuals. DD Resources also allocates funding for 39 agencies that provide the expert services needed for over 1,300 individuals in St. Louis City to live as respected and included members of their community.

**OUR MISSION** is to ensure individuals with developmental disabilities in the City of St. Louis have quality services, choices, and full inclusion.

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### Funded Services

DD Resources funds diverse services and promotes the power of choice regarding living, employment, and social activities that best meet individuals' needs and goals.

**Community Connection** services support individuals with their physical and/or emotional well-being, accessing their community and social life in inclusive ways, and strengthening their natural and formal supports.

*Examples: Community Integration, Professional Services, Family Support, Community Transportation*

**Independent Living** services support individuals with establishing, developing, and maintaining skills needed to live in the community.

*Examples: Supportive Housing, Independent Supported Living Assistance (ISLA), Independent Living Assistance Fund (ILAF)*

**Employment** services support individuals to develop skills necessary to gain/maintain employment and/or advance in their career.

*Examples: Employment Training, Supported Employment, Sheltered Employment, Employment Transportation*
